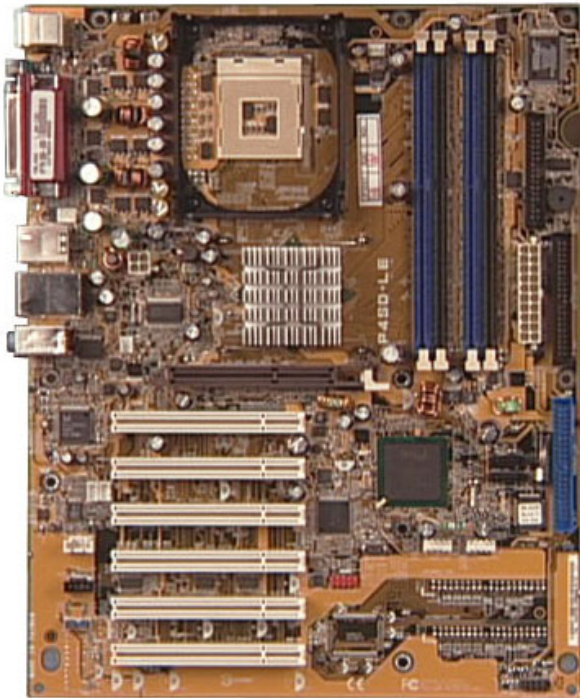

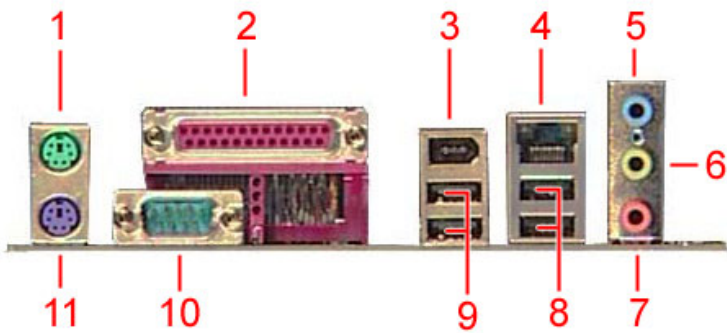

## Clearing the CMOS settings

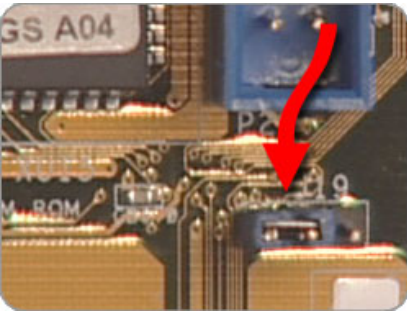
The Clear RTC RAM (J19) jumper allows you to clear the Real Time Clock (RTC) in CMOS. It also allows clearing of date, time, and PC setup parameter memories in CMOS, by erasing the RTC RAM data. The onboard button cell battery powers the RAM data in CMOS, including PC setup information.

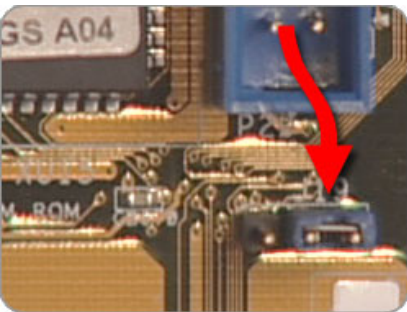


**CAUTION:** Do not change any jumper setting while the PC is running. Damage to the motherboard may result.

1. Turn off the PC and unplug the power cord.
2. Move the J19 jumper cap from pins 2-3 (Normal) to pins 1-2 (Clear CMOS).



3. Keep the J19 jumper cap on pins 1-2 for 5-10 seconds, then move it back to pins 2-3.



4. Plug in the power cord and turn on the PC.
5. From startup press **F1** to enter BIOS Setup and change any custom settings.
